Hospital Annual Meeting

The hospital annual meeting will be held July 25th this year. In the past, the hospital annual meeting was held on the third Monday in June. Due to the financial auditors having such a short window of time from fiscal year end (April 30th) to annual meeting date of the third Monday in June, the past several years only preliminary financial reports have been available. In order to provide final audited financial reports the

governing board voted to move the annual meeting date to occur "within 120 days of the fiscal year end". According to David Bailey, CEO, "this will allow the auditors more time to complete their year-end audits and provide final financials to the community at the annual meeting." Governing board elections are held at the annual meeting; thus, the elections for this year will be held on July 25th as well.

The Bremen Medical Center, located at 1144 W. Plymouth Street, Bremen, is home to Laura Foudy, MD and Lindy Sergeant, MD. The Board Certified physicians provide family medicine and obstetrical services. They provide a full spectrum of care from birth to geriatrics in order to provide care for your entire family. The Bremen Medical Center offers an electronic medical record complete with a patient portal. The patient portal allows patients to send messages to the clinical staff, request medication refills, and access their medical records.

Bremen Medical Center is a Reach Out and Read literacy program site. Through this unique program, children between 6 months through 5 years of age receive free developmentally-appropriate books at each well child visit to take home. Each child who participates in Reach Out and Read starts kindergarten with a home library of up to 10 books and a parent who has heard at every regular checkup about the importance of books and reading.

The Bremen Medical Center is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Dr. Foudy and Dr. Sergeant are accepting new patients. To schedule an appointment, call 574-546-5363.
